Vide Board's letter under reference, submission of summary of Medical Report for the APAR year 2020-21 was extended upto 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

In view of the prevailing situation of pandemic spread of COVID-19, it has been decided by the competent authority to delink the submission of summary of Medical Report from recording and completion of APAR for the year 2020-21. The timeline for conduct of Annual Medical Examination and thereafter submitting the summary of the Medical Report for the year 2020-21 is extended for a further period upto 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2021. However, recording and completion of APAR for the year 2020-21 may be done as per schedule, without insisting on submission of summary of Medical Report.
