

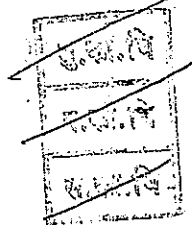

Sub:- Retention of Railway accommodation by the family in case of death of a Railway employee.

Board's instructions contained in letter No.E(G)92 RN2-7, dated 27.08.93 provide that the family of a Railway employee who dies while in service, may be permitted to retain the Railway quarter for a period of 12 months on payment of normal rent from the date of death of an employee.

The above instructions have been reviewed by Board and it has been decided that the permissible period of retention may be increased from 12 months to 24 months in the case of death of allottee Railway employee. This facility will also continue to be available to audit staff doing Railway audit work. No further extension beyond twenty - four months shall be allowed. The family of the deceased allottee shall be required to apply for such retention. The extended period of retention of 12 months, shall, however, not be permissible in cases where the deceased Staff Officer or his/her dependents own a house at the place of posting.

These orders shall take effect from the date of issue of this letter. However, permissible period of retention as indicated above, may be allowed in past cases which have not yet been decided. The cases that have already been decided, need not be reopened suo moto.

This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
